While at Santa Ana PD he worked undercover in a Vice capacity. During his time in vice he received a commendation for his assistance in a prostitution suppression taskforce.

Officer Stills has an Associates of Arts Degree in Liberal Arts from Santiago Canyon College and working toward a Bachelor of Arts Degree in Criminal Justice at Cal State San Bernardino.
