## **SBVC LIBRARY** **RULES OF CONDUCT**

1. Interfere with another person's use of the Library or with Library personnel's performance of their duties.
2. Consume food or beverages (except water from the drinking fountain,) anywhere in the Library.
3. Sleep anywhere in the Library, sit on the floor or the stairs, or lie or lounge on the floor.
4. Use cell phones to make or receive calls in the Library.
5. Smoke anywhere in the Library, including the restrooms.
6. Play audio equipment so loudly that others can hear it. The use of head sets is permitted as long as such use does not disturb any other Library patrons or staff members.
7. Engage in lewd behavior.
8. Talk loudly, make noise whistle, sing, shout, use abusive or threatening language, or engage in other disruptive conduct.
9. Bring animals into the Library, except those needed to assist a patron with a disability.
10. Use of Internet to access pornographic web sites.
11. Use the restrooms for bathing.
12. Leave children unattended in the Library, or allow them to run about, talk in a voice louder than a whisper, or engage in other behavior that is disruptive to study and reading.
13. Solicit anywhere in the Library.
14. Go barefoot or without a shirt inside the Library building.
15. Lie down on furniture, put feet up on furniture, or move furniture (other than chairs at tables).
16. Ask Library personnel to store or watch over personal belongings. In addition, any unattended belongings (such as bags, back packs, briefcases, etc...) will be turned over to the Campus Police.

San Bernardino Community College District Administrative Procedure – 3570

It is a violation of district policy to smoke in any area not officially marked/designated as a smoking area. The College Police are authorized by the Board of Trustees to enforce this policy, consistent with CA Gov. Codes 7596-7598, Education Code 76033(e). Additional sanctions can be placed through other administrative means consistent with the Standards of Conduct and Disciplinary Procedures, Board Policy/Administrative Procedure 5500.

Any subsequent violations of the San Bernardino Community College District Smoking Administrative Regulation may result in disciplinary action against you. Violations of this regulation by persons not a student or employee may result in your arrest for Trespass (Penal Code 626.4.)

### LITTERING

Any person who places any cigarette or any portion of a cigarette on the San Bernardino Valley College, Crafton Hills College, or San Bernardino Community College District will be issued a citation for littering. The mandatory fine for littering is \$250 and not more than \$1000. A second conviction is punishable by a fine of \$500 to \$1500 and a 3rd conviction is punishable by a fine of at least \$750 and not more than \$3000. (Penal Code 374.4)
