NEW YEARS SAFETY PLANNING

Have you made your new year's resolutions? This year, consider adding a resolution or two that focuses on safety. We've talked about many tips this year and focused on numerous things that you can do to Live Safe. These are familiar messages, but important reminders. Use this annual time of renewal to make safety a priority.

Emergency Planning

A Safety Kit will be prepared and stored in an accessible place at home.

Your safety kit should be waterproof and portable, and contain the following:

Bottled water — one gallon per adult per day for three days.

Food — nonperishable food bars and snacks, and canned baby formula.

Flashlights and one radio

First aid kit and blankets

Medications — update prescribed meds and review expiration dates.

Copies of important documents and data — in a waterproof bag, place copies of passport, driver's license, credit cards, birth certificates, recent medical prescriptions, and any other important personal documents.

Safety plan — write down emergency plans. Where will the family meet? Who will pick up children at school?
